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## ANNUAL REPORT 2017-18

It gives us immense pleasure to present Annual Report 2017-18 of our institution, Sakaldiha P.G. College the oldest institution of higher education in our district Chandauli and every year we try to do our best to improve our performance qualitatively as well as quantitatively. College exercises its policies and implements planning through IQAC and its various committees/cells/bodies.

### Admission

In session 2017-18, 859 students are admitted in graduation and post-graduation level. Total 1622 students are enrolled in institution.

### Student Union Election

According to recommendations made by Lingdoh Committee and rules and regulations of M G Kashi Vidyapeeth Varansi, student election took place. Students elected for the posts of President, Vice President, General Secretary, Pustkalay Mantry and Kala Sankay Pratinidhi.

### Infrastructural Development

1. Budget of Rs 8.5 lakhs allocated for infrastructure augmentation and incurred Rs .31 lakh only on infrastructure maintenance.
2. Old benches replaced by new.
3. Rs. 1.83 lakh only are expended on green initiative and waste management in current academic session.
4. Institution take an internet connection of 5 MBPS and develop other ICT facilities.

### **Financial Expenses and Distribution**

1. Scholarship provided by Deptt. Of Social Welfare, Government of Uttar Pradesh (UP) to 1348 students and 17 students benefited by freeships by institution.
2. College provided financial assistance to two faculty members to attend seminars/workshops/symposium etc.
3. ICT- Upgradation of offices and class rooms taken place.
4. Total budget of Rs. 57.28 lakhs only expended excluding salary component in academic year 2017-18.

### **Academic Achievements –**

1. Four faculty members joined the institution in <sup>aided</sup> ~~added~~ and four faculty members joined in self-finance courses in this session.
2. To impart quality education to students is our goal and to achieve this goal we engage ourselves in a number of academic and extracurricular activities throughout the year. Besides regular classes we organized annual lectures for the benefit of our student. Due to our combined effort, our students did well in annual examination 2017 and P.G. semester examination.
3. In the session institution got affiliation of Physical Education at graduation level. Near about 80 students took admission in this subject and classes are regularly held in this subject. Thus in total eleven subjects are studied at UG level. In this session, we got affiliation of two subjects English and Sociology at P.G. level. Thus in our college P.G. course is available in 5 subjects Geography, Hindi, Political Science, English and Sociology.
4. Educational tour is the part of geography syllabus. In September, 2017 10-days tour of Pune and nearby areas was organized. During 20-25 February 2018, 5 days tour of Kolkata and Ganga Sagar was organized for the benefit of our students.
5. Total 4 research papers has published in UGC notified journals and 3 chapters contributed in books and edited volumes' by faculty members.



### **NAAC Accreditation**

During session 2017-18, institution successfully submitted IQA and Self Study Report (SSR) on 20 February, 2018 to NAAC Bangalore and is in process of evaluation by NAAC for first cycle.

### **Library and Reading Room**

Rs. 1.02 lakhs has expended on purchase of books and journals in this academic session. Moreover, institution take the membership of N-List.

### **IGNOU Study Center**

In session 2017-18, institution started Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) study center. The opening of IGNOU study center has been a great achievement for our collage in the academic session 2017-18. A number of student have taken their admission in IGNOU study center. The Co-ordinate of IGNOU Dr. Dayandhi Singh Yadav is trying his best to provide facilities to students.

### **Student Guidance Programmes**

1. Institutional 'Career Counselling & Placement Cell' organizes one day "Guidance and Counselling Workshop" for students related to professional courses in joint venture with Kalling University on 06 February, 2018 in college campus.
2. Free NET coaching is being provided to students by institutional 'Career Counselling & Placement Cell'.
3. 845 Students benefitted by career counselling and competitive examinations.

### **Anamika - Annual Magazine**

Our College magazine "Anamika" is a colorful summarization of our efforts towards the excellence. To encourage the creativity and writing skill among students and to give them a platform to express their original thoughts, the college bring out a magazine named "Anamika" in which the articles on different subjects by students, teachers and the employees are published.

A unit of rovers named as “Vivekanand Rovers Crew” is working. Students are selected by a selection committee framed by head of institutions.


### **National Social Service (NSS) Programme**
